




Finding A School Local School Districts

Information:

There are several school districts in the serving the Fort Bragg area. There are also many options for K-12 education for our families. The information below provides more about the local schools that serve our Military-Connected children, including public, charter, private schools, and home school information.



Fort Bragg Schools

Fort Bragg Schools falls under the Department of Defense Education Agency, it is NOT North Carolina Public Schools.

Fort Bragg operates schools on the main Fort Bragg cantonment area and in Linden Oaks. Only families residing on Fort Bragg or in Linden Oaks are eligible to attend Fort Bragg Schools.

If you are living off post, you MAY NOT attend Fort Bragg schools. There are NO exceptions to policy.

However, if you are temporarily living off post and are within 90-school days of residing on post, and housing can provide a 90-day letter, you may enroll your children on post. You will have to provide your own transportation.

Fort Bragg School run from Pre-K through 8th Grade. All high school students on post attend public schools off post.

The host high school for Fort Bragg is <u>EE Smith High School</u> with Cumberland County Schools. The host high school for Linden Oaks <u>Overhills High School</u> with Harnett County Schools.

Cumberland County Schools is the largest school district surrounding Fort Bragg. It has over 80 schools, including over 10 different high schools.

It has the greatest options of schools including <u>Governed Choice Programs</u> and Traditional and Year Round Schedules.

Harnett County Schools is growing. It is the second largest school district in the area; there are 4 high schools in Harnett County Schools.

Most of our Military Families live in the southern part of Harnett County. Overhills High School and Western Harnett High School, and the surrounding elementary and middle schools have the greatest Military-connected student populations.

Hoke County Schools is the smallest school district in the immediate Fort Bragg area. Many Military Families live in the Raeford area, on the east side of the county.

There is only 1 high school and 3 middle schools.
