SUMMARY:

Families with school-age children residing on Fort Bragg attend schools in the district in which they live. Only Families living on Military federal property can enroll their children on Fort Bragg Schools (K-8th Grade). EE Smith High School (Cumberland County Schools) serves Fort Bragg's main post high school students. Overhills High School (Harnett County Schools) serves Linden Oaks high school students.

Families that decide to reside in off post housing are encouraged to research local schools prior to selecting a place to live. School districts generally do not allow out of district enrollment. Please double check with the Fort Bragg School Support Services or the school district's central services to determine your school.

SCHOOL REGISTRATION:

At what age can my child start school?

The child must be five years old on or before August 31st of the year he/she is presented for enrollment to be eligible to enroll for public schools. For Fort Bragg Schools, the child must be five years old on or before September 1st.

What is required for enrollment?

1. Birth Certificate
2. Shot Record
3. Health Assessment
4. Proof of Parent/Custodian address
5. Copy of orders (on post schools)
6. Custody or guardian papers filed through the court. (if applicable)

How do I enroll for school?

Enrollment is handled at the local level. Please contact your school district for further details.

Remember, where you live is where your child will attend school. Please contact School Support Services for more info.

SCHOOL CHOICE OPTIONS:

- **Cumberland County Schools Governed Choice Program:** Only for Cumberland County students. Choice schools for K-12.
- **Private Schools:** There are several private schools around Fort Bragg. Please visit PrivateSchoolReview.com to view available schools.
- **Home Schools:** Families can elect to home school their children. Parent must have a high school diploma or GED. Home School Families must register through the Division of Non-Public Education. For more information, please visit ncdnpe.org.
- **Charter Schools:** Charter schools provide a public school choice. The schools have open enrollment and no tuition. Please visit www.ncpublicschools.org/charterschools to view the charter schools in North Carolina.

REMINDERS:

- After you enroll, return to the school and provide the school with updated contact information.
- Fort Bragg/School Support Services cannot supersede school policies.
- All high schools surrounding Fort Bragg are on a 4x4 schedule.
Contact your school administrators before withdrawing your child from school.
- Communicate with your school as soon as you get orders prior to leaving.
