SCHEDULE: Classes are presently conducted:

- Monday/Wednesday or
 - Tuesday/Thursday
- Fridays will be used as make-ups for facility closures.

FEES:

- Students 4-5 year olds have 8 x 45-minute classes per month for \$32.
- Students 6+ year olds have 8 x 60-minute classes per month for \$35.

Makeups will be offered when the entire class is cancelled due to inclement weather or unforeseen situations involving the entire class (instructor illness). Those missing due to pre-scheduled doctor's visit or travelling are not entitled to a makeup class.

Priority Registration is offered to each child currently enrolled in our program. Billing will post to your account on the 18th of the month preceding instruction when the 18th falls on a business day (when it falls on a weekend or holiday - billing will process on the following business day). Priority Registration ends three calendar days after billing - on the 4th day after billing, anyone with a balance due will be dropped from class assuming it is your intent to withdraw from the class. An email reminder will be sent to all email addresses included in your profile from paul.t.driessen2.civ@mail.mil. Please ensure that official emails do not get routed to your SPAM folder.

Uniform: at the beginning, students will train in t-shirt, shorts and bare feet on the mats. The uniform (Gi) is not required until the students get ready to test for their first belt. So, after a month or two when families know that this is really something that your child would like to study, then our contractor has uniforms for sale with the school logo screened on the back. The white traditional Gi is normally purchased for a first uniform.

Children must have some foot protection (sandals/crocs/shoes) when walking in the parking lot and through hallways but on the mat, they are generally bare footed.

Families are encouraged to observe a class that you are considering joining to ensure that this is something that you would like to pursue. Prospective children may not participate in the class due to insurance restrictions.
