DIAL 6 - BOSS is a means of communicating with the Commanding General. Your suggestions, ideas, recommendations, or bon-a-fide complaints are welcome to make Fort Bragg a better place to live and work. Calls are transcribed daily and submitted to the appropriate agency for follow-up. The Commanding General reviews all calls and responses are made to the individual initiating the call. Anonymous calls will be acted upon on a case-by-case basis. Prior to using **DIAL 6 - BOSS**, you should use your chain of command; however, the Commanding General remains available to any Soldier and/or family member needing help.

DIAL 6 - BOSS rules are simple: 1) Wait for the sound of the tone after the recording and leave your full name (spell your last name), social security number, unit or address, and a telephone number;
2) Since your message is being recorded, keep your comments to less than three minutes.

Donating blood is a simple way almost anyone can save up to three lives. The actual donation only takes 10 – 15 minutes, but there are steps that come before and after donation that keep donors and the blood supply safe and healthy. In general, the entire process takes 45 minutes to one hour.

BABY BUNDLES

This program provides a layette for new mothers who are active duty, E-4 and below, and for the spouses of an active duty Soldier/Airman E-4 and below. The layettes are delivered by volunteers every day, including holidays, to the Mother/Baby Unit at Womack. .

BEFORE & AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAMS

Eligibility:

- Active duty Soldiers (single or married), and eligible Family members.
- National Guard and Reservist Soldiers on active duty (w/Title 10 Orders) for more than 30 consecutive days and their eligible Family members.
- Soldiers retired from active duty for longevity or physical disability, and their eligible Family members.
- National Guard and Reservist Soldiers who retired at age 60, and their eligible Family members.
- Surviving spouses, or children of Soldiers who died while on active duty or after they retired.

Procedures for Assistance

Overview: The Fort Bragg School System is composed of one primary schools (pre-K – 1st grades), one intermediate school (2nd – 5th grades), five elementary schools (pre-K – 5th grades), two middle schools (6th - 8th grades). Students in grades nine through twelve attend high schools in Cumberland or Harnett Counties. (See below for **Cumberland County Schools**) Each school under the direction of Fort Bragg School system is fully accredited by ADvancED.

Special Education: One of the most unique aspects of Fort Bragg Schools is the work done with special needs children. The Special Education Program offers a full continuum of services to include consultation, inclusion, resource rooms, self-contained classes, and homebound instruction. Eligible students receive services from Speech/Language Pathologists, Occupational Therapists, Physical Therapists, and Psychologists. An extended school year is available to students who demonstrate significant regression and recoupment issues.

Fort Bragg School Board: Being a school board member is a serious responsibility but one that offers significant rewards - the primary reward being the opportunity to actively participate in the process of educating our children. However, unlike the school boards in the Local Education Authority (LEA), DDESS school boards act purely in an advisory capacity, providing input to the Superintendent and administrators in the areas of

fiscal, personnel and educational policies, procedures and programs. The DDESS school district superintendent makes final decisions on matters affecting the school district.

Service Provided: The North Carolina Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) requires automobile owners to have liability insurance coverage before registering your car in North Carolina. State law requires that you register your vehicle within 30 days of establishing residence in the State. The DMV also recommends replacement of your driver's license at that time. North Carolina plates are only good if you hold continuous insurance. Should your insurance lapse at any time your license plate must be surrendered to the DMV. To re-license your vehicle, you must pay a \$25.00 fee in addition to the cost of the license plate. To obtain North Carolina license tags, you must have:

1. Insurance (name and policy number). If new policy, name of agent and agency.
2. Title (in owner's name) or properly reassigned to them. If the bank holds your title, you must have current registration and name and address of bank.
3. If you came from a non-title state, you need the current registration and 2 notarized copies of the bill of sale from the last two owners.

3. All active, Guard, Reserve, and retired personnel must present a DOD Uniformed Services ID card for services.
4. Wildlife and exotic animals (ferrets, skunks, raccoons, wolves, wolf hybrids, etc.) are not authorized to be housed on Fort Bragg and will not be treated at this facility.

Benefits: WIC participants receive nutrition education and supplemental food to improve their diets and reduce their chances of health problems caused by poor nutrition. They are given vouchers that they redeem at participating grocery stores to obtain WIC foods. Foods include: milk, cheese, eggs, iron fortified cereal, vitamin C enriched juices, dry beans/peas, peanut butter, and for infants: iron fortified Enfamil, iron fortified Prosobee, iron fortified lactofree, iron fortified infant cereal, vitamin C enriched juices.

Program Eligibility:

- A pregnant woman or one who has recently had a baby or is breast-feeding an infant less than 12 months of age.
- An infant
- A child who has not reached their fifth birthday
- Meet local agency eligibility scale. The gross annual income cannot exceed 185% of poverty. All Medicaid, Food Stamps, and Work First recipients meet WIC income eligibility.
- Nutritional/medical eligibility must also be met. This is determined by staff health professionals.

STEP 1

It is important to update your information in the Defense Enrollment Eligibility Reporting System (DEERS) with your current address and other information to ensure you continue receiving your medical benefits. You can do this by calling **1-800-538-9552**, or by visiting the main ID Card Facility in the Soldier Support Center (SSC) on the 1st floor and can be reached by calling **396 - 9339** or online.

STEP 2

Enroll in TRICARE

Eligible beneficiaries may call **1 – 877 – TRICARE (874-2273)** to request an enrollment packet or go online www.tricare.mil

TRICARE OPTIONS

TRICARE Prime is the only option for Active-Duty Family Members, Retirees and their Families who are not Medicare eligible need to enroll in. Active-Duty Family Members are automatically enrolled after filling out the enrollment form. Active-Duty family members do not have an enrollment fee. Retirees pay \$282.60 per year for themselves or \$565.20 for the entire family to receive healthcare. These rates are subject to change each fiscal year.

TRICARE Extra saves money but it limits your choice of providers. You may only use authorized civilian providers. There is no enrollment process for **TRICARE Standard** or **TRICARE Extra**.

TRICARE Standard offers the most choice of providers at the highest cost. Family Members and Retirees pay current deductibles and cost shares.

TRICARE for Life (TFL) is Medicare-wraparound coverage for TRICARE-eligible beneficiaries who have Medicare Part A and B. For more info go to <http://www.tricare.mil/Plans/HealthPlans/TFL.aspx>

STEP 3 **CLINIC ENROLLMENT**

Active duty service members are assigned to primary care clinics based on their unit designation. Family members can be assigned to an on-post clinic or off-post medical home after they enroll in Tricare Prime. Our primary care clinics are your entry point into the healthcare system. You are strongly encouraged to visit your primary care clinic for clinic orientation and in-processing.

MEDICAL RECORDS **Areas of Responsibility**

The Womack Outpatient Medical Records maintains the outpatient medical records for all beneficiaries who receive their care in Womack Specialty clinics. If you receive your medical care at any of our Outpatient Clinics in the area, your Outpatient Medical records are maintained at those locations.

Requesting Copies of Records

Outpatient Medical Records are retired 3 years after a patient's last recorded clinic visit. Patients must show their identification card when requesting a copy of their records. The Privacy Act and HIPAA prohibits parents from picking up the medical records of their children who are over the age of 18 without written permission and an identification card.

Request for Transfer of Records

Records may not be hand carried by patients according to current Laws and Department of Defense Policy. If you require a record transfer, contact your servicing medical records section for instructions on how to transfer your records to the new location.

SCHEDULING APPOINTMENTS

To make a **primary care appointment**, patients should call the central appointment line at 907 – APPT (2778). Central appointment line hours are 0700 – 1700 week days. They can also call their assigned clinic, or visit www.tricareonline.com for appointments.

To book a **specialty appointment**, you must first receive a referral from your Primary Care Provider, then call 1-877- TRICARE.

To **cancel** an appointment call 907 – CNCL (2625). If you have forgotten your appointment date, you can also call this line to hear upcoming appointments up to 45 days in advance.

TRICARE APPOINTMENTS ONLINE

All primary care appointments available over the phone are also available online. Just visit www.tricareonline.com and register. Once you're logged in, click "Appointments" then select a "Visit Reason" followed by "View Available Appointments." You can view all available appointments for your primary care manager and select one that meets your needs. You can schedule appointments at your convenience, without worrying about being put on hold.

ARMY MEDICINE SECURE MESSAGING SERVICE

Secure messaging, also sometimes referred to as Relay Health, is web-based service that gives providers and patients the ability to communicate securely online. The interactive website allows you to initiate a consultation, receive preventive care reminders, send a note to the provider's office, request prescription renewals and refills, request lab or test results, and request appointments. Unlike a phone conversation, it also provides an audit trail so patients and providers can view the entire message history. You can sign-up for secure messaging at your primary care clinic during your visit. It only takes a few minutes and it can potentially save you hours of time in the future.

ACCESSING CARE AFTER HOURS NURSE ADVICE LINE (NAL)

All TRICARE eligible patients may call the NAL 24/7 by calling 1-800-TRICARE, Option 1. There is no cost to patients. They can help you make informed decisions about self-care at home or when to see a health care provider.

EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT

Womack Army Medical Center is a Level I, full service Emergency Department. The Emergency Department (ED) provides continuous, uninterrupted pre-hospital and hospital based emergency services. Ambulatory patients or visitors will enter the Emergency Department at the clearly marked first floor South Entrance into Womack Army Medical Center. The Emergency Department entrances are well marked from both inside and outside of the hospital.

FOR MORE LIFE-THREATENING EMERGENCIES CALL 911.

An emergency is defined as "a medical condition that arises suddenly and threatens the life or the welfare of a person or a group of people, a natural disaster or a medical crisis." Examples may include: heart attacks, automobile injuries, poisonings, burns, injuries caused by violence, animal bites, broken bones, chest pains/shortness of breath, and severe depression.

The Womack Army Medical Center Emergency Department is for **EMERGENCIES**. Patients presenting to the Emergency Department with non-urgent and non-emergent cases are triaged by a licensed registered nurse and seen by a medical care provider according to the Emergency Service Index (ESI). Non-urgent patients are subject a wait time of greater than 1-2 hours pending the level of triage and availability of medical staff.
