## Rifle and Pistol Range Standard Operating Procedures

**HOURS:** Monday and Tuesday Closed

Wednesday, Thursday, Friday 1100 – 1700 Saturday and Sunday 1000 – 1700

**FEES:** Membership \$50.00 per year

Members' Daily Charge \$6.00 per day

Members' Guests \$7.00 per day (per guest, up to 2 guests)

Non-Members \$11.00 per day

Everyone that uses the Range must get a briefing, read the SOP, sign-in and pay fees.

#### **OPERATION OF THE RANGES:**

The rifle and pistol ranges are controlled and supervised by the range officer in addition to post range regulations. The following regulations and procedures govern the operation of these ranges.

### PERSONS PERMITTED TO USE RANGE:

Active Duty, Retired, Reserve, National Guard, DOD Civilians, and Civilians

Guests: Persons (up to two), whose presence within the premises of the range, which is in response to a specific invitation from an active member. The member assumes responsibility for the guest and payment for services rendered. Dependents' with a legal ID card proving their age, is authorized to use the range, when accompanied by an active member. Children age 10 and older must be accompanied by an adult while shooting. Children under 10 will not be allowed on the range.

Age: Must be 10 years of age or older to go on the range. Children 10 and older must be accompanied by an adult.

#### **FIREARMS AUTHORIZED ON RANGES:**

Hand and shoulder fired, sporting type firearms of .50 calibers or less, or black power weapons are permitted on the ranges. At the specific discretion of the Range Safety Officer, shotguns with rifled slugs will be permitted on the rifle and pistol range. Military issued weapons will not be permitted on the range (Post Ranges and Military Police accepted), unless the personal property of the shooter. No fully automatic firearms will be permitted on the ranges at any time. Weapons larger than .50 calibers, except black power, must be cleared for firing by the Range Officer on duty.
