WONDERFUL WORLD FOR KIDS

• Requires CYS Services Registration. CYS Services cards are free and will be provided at Parent Central Services. For your convenience, to start the registration process you can go online and obtain an appointment with CYS Services Parent Central Services. After Initial registration participants may also be enrolled at WWK SAC or online.

To Register you must have:

- 1) Identification (Proof of Eligibility)
- 2) Child's birth certificate
- 3) LES/pay stub for you and your spouse
- 4) Three (3) local Emergency contacts other than you or your spouse.
- 5) Each new parent must attend an onsite orientation prior to attending.
- Health Assessment and Family Care Plan is required within 30 days after child starts attending SAC.
- Total Army Strong discounts available for qualified families for 20% discount on monthly care fees. Must be applied for prior to the 15th of the month for the next month's service.
- Free breakfast and after school snack, lunch provided on full days.
- Fees are based on Total Family Income, covers full day, out of school programs.
- Daily free-choice activities, character education programs, and volunteer opportunities.
- Drop Off and Pick Up Services available to Bowley and Devers Elementary Schools.
- Out of school camps for school age youth who do not require services before and after school.
- 4-H and Boys & Girls Club of America (BGCA) affiliation.



- SAC Site is Council on Accreditation Nationally accredited and DOD Certified
- Open Recreation—CYS Services cardholders receive 4 free hours of Open Recreation. Before & After School participants received their free hours in their monthly fees. Must be pre-registered. Register by calling 396-2011.
- Hourly care rate is \$4 per hour, five hours maximum per week, per child, only available on school days. Daily rate \$30 for full day camps or \$16.00 for 4 or less hours on full school out days. Hourly care available at Maholic CDC on school out days.
- 16 hours a month of free care available through Total Army Strong Initiative for qualified families—can be used for Care at Maholic CDC.
- Emergency After Hour Care provided by CYSS Family Child Care, 396-3415/2326.
