- Requires CYSS Registration. CYSS cards are free and will be provided at CYSS Parent Central Services, Wonderful World for Kids off Knox Street, (910) 396-8110. Initial enrollment must be completed at Parent Central Services. For your convenience, to start the registration process you can go online and obtain an appointment with Parent Central Services. After Initial enrollment participants may also be enrolled at Baez SAC or online.

To Register you must have:

- 1) Identification (Proof of Eligibility)
- 2) Child's birth certificate
- 3) Immunization record for grades K-5th
- 4) LES/pay stub for you and your spouse
- 5) Three (3) local Emergency contacts other than you or your spouse.
- 6) Each new parent must attend an onsite orientation prior to attending.

- Health Assessment and Family Care Plan is required within 30 days of registration date.
- Total Army Strong discounts available for qualified families for 20% discount on monthly care fees. Must be applied for prior to the 15th of the month for the next month's service.
- Free breakfast and after school snack, lunch provided on full days.
- Fees are based on Total Family Income, covers full day, out of school programs.
- Daily free-choice activities, character education programs, and volunteer opportunities.
- Drop Off and Pick Up Services available to Butner, Hampton, Irwin, Devers, and W. T. Brown schools.
- 4-H and Boys & Girls Club of America (BGCA) affiliation.



- SAC Site is DOD Certified and Council on Accreditation National Accreditation.
- Open Recreation—CYSS cardholders receive four free hours of Open Recreation, Before & After School participants free hours are built into the monthly fee. Must be pre-registered with CYSS. Register by calling (910) 908-2828.
- Occasional hourly care rate is \$4 per hour, five hours maximum per week, per child. Daily rate \$30
- 16 hours a month of free care available through Total Army Strong initiative for qualified families—can be used for Extended Care at Maholic or Rodriguez CDC
- Emergency After Hours Care provided by CYSS Family Child Care, 396-3415/2326.
