

BEACH RULES

1. Beach is open to ID card holders and their guests. Patrons show their ID prior to use. Guest of ID card holders must provide valid form of ID if 15 or older.
2. ADULT SUPERVISION: Any ID card holder under the age of 13 must be accompanied by an adult guardian 18 years of age or older. Patrons 7 and under must be within arm's reach of an adult guardian 18 years of age or older at all times.
3. ID card holders must accompany their guests to the lake. Limit four guests per ID card holder. Guests defined as persons who do not have a DoD ID card. ID card holders are responsible for the conduct of their guests. ID card holders and their guests must use the lake in a safe manner.
4. Patrons must wear swimsuits that are appropriate for public appearance.
5. Children who are not toilet trained must wear swim diapers while in the lake. Change diapers in the restrooms, not on the beach.
6. No food or drinks allowed within 50ft of the beach front. No glass containers or personal grills allowed in the beach.
7. Persons with skin disorders bandages open wounds, eye, nose or mouth discharge may be refused entrance to the facility.
8. Lake will be cleared 10 minutes before each hour (Example 12:50 to 1300) to allow for safety checks.
9. Absolutely no running, horseplay, diving, or obscene language permitted within the facility.
10. No Smoking / Vaping
11. No boats, inflatable rafts are not permitted in the swimming area.
12. Young children may wear Coast Guard approved life vests on the beach. Children must be within arm's reach of an adult guardian 18 years of age or older at all times.
13. Prolonged underwater breath-holding is strictly prohibited.
14. No pets allowed in the beach area.
15. The beach and beach areas are off-limits when closed.

16. Lifeguards will be provided during posted hours and will have the authority to close the beach for weather or safety reasons. Patrons and their guests must comply with Lifeguards' instructions or face loss of use privileges.
17. No outside alcoholic beverages are allowed in the beach area. Intoxicated patrons will be denied entry and asked to vacate the premises.
18. Lifeguards will be obeyed and shall have the authority to issue guidance on anything not covered in the Beach Rules/SOP.
19. Lifeguards and Management will monitor the number of patrons allowed inside the beach area at any one time in order to stay within maximum capacity requirements. Access granted on a first come, first serve basis.
20. ID Holders and their guests use the beach at their own risk.
21. Patrons must use shower and toilet before entering the beach area.
22. No diving from the docks / No running on the docks.
23. Allowed Aquatic Items: Pool noodles, Kickboards, Fins and Infant float/carriers with pressure/ tire valve.
24. Prohibited Aquatic Items: Water guns, Inflatable rafts, Water Wings / Floaties and Mermaid Fins.
25. No extreme displays of public affection
26. On-site telephone is for emergency use only
27. No refunds, no rainchecks
