



BRAGGIN' BUCKS INCENTIVES

We recognize and understand how registration and documentation of hours can be seen as an unnecessary burden for someone who just wants to give of their time. However, it is required by regulation and it does serve an important purpose! Proper registration provides accountability for volunteer activity and signing the DD2793 protects the volunteer should they be injured while performing duties outlined in the position description. Documentation of hours allows the chain of command to see the actual impact volunteers are having on the individual activities as well as the overall installation mission. All hours logged properly by day since October 1, 2009 count towards these incentives!

Braggin' Bucks Cash in Values

25 bucks	Glass Candy Jar!
100 bucks	Camouflage Journal
200 bucks	Camouflage Lunch Tote – great to take with you on volunteer days! (limit 1)
200 bucks	Lightweight Windbreaker
300 bucks**	Hooded Sweatshirt – how off your volunteer spirit! (limit 1)
400 bucks	Backpack (limit 1)
500 bucks**	Sports Duffel Bag – great for a weekend getaway or daily workout gear! (limit 1)

All items are subject to availability and may be limited in how many you can choose over your time here at Fort Bragg.

****These items are limited to the specific number indicated per volunteer per lifetime.**

Guidelines

- Earn a buck for every hour logged/certified in the system beginning October 1, 2009. Only hours entered during the OPEN REPORTING PERIODS are counted. Historical hours entered by period, hours already in the system as of September 30, 2009, or hours from other installations are NOT counted toward your "bucks" total. Your DA4713/VSR in VMIS will verify your totals.
- Cash in your bucks on any of the items above - cash them in as you go, or save them up for the bigger items. Please note that once you cash in any of your bucks, that number of bucks is now gone. As you log additional hours, you earn additional bucks.
- Items can be picked up in the ACS, Installation Volunteer Services Office AFTER the 20th of the month. All items have the Army Volunteer Corps logo.

- All items are subject to limited availability – WHEN THEY RUN OUT, THEY'RE GONE – new items may not be ordered until next year!!!

NOW PHASING OUT - PARACHUTE LAPEL PIN & WINGS – We are on the final supply of the lapel pin with the hourly wing add-ons. Volunteers receive a Volunteer Parachute Lapel Pin once they are registered and 250 hours are logged in the Volunteer Management Information System (VMIS) on <https://vmis.armyfamilywebportal.com>. A set of wings in 250 hour increments is awarded after the initial pin for 500, 750, 1,000, 1,250, 1,500, 1,750, 2,000, 2,250, & 2,500. Only hours entered by day during the open reporting period are counted; historical hours entered by period do not count. Pins and wings can be picked up by the volunteer at any time after the end of the reporting period (15th of the month)!
